FAQ Frequently Asked Questions

Question: Where is Cedar Valley Court located?

Answer: Cedar Valley Court is situated in Orisha, Temu-Epe, off Epe-Itokin Road, within Epe LGA, Lagos

State, Nigeria.

Landmarks: Lekki International Airport, Lagos Film City, LASUED, YABATECH, Augustine

University, and the Lagos Central Food System and Logistics Park.

Question: Who is the developer of Cedar Valley Court? **Answer:** Landfount Investment and Properties Ltd.

Question: What type of title does Cedar Valley Court have on the land?

Answer: Community Gazette, C of O, Registered Survey & Deed of Assignment from the ancestral owner.

Question: What type of infrastructure will the developer provide?

Answer: Perimeter fencing, gatehouse, security, electricity, drainage, and tarred road.

Question: What is the payment structure?

Question: What is the time frame for the complete payment for land?

Answer: After an initial deposit has been paid, a purchaser has a maximum of four (4) months to complete

payment for the land within the Structure specified (A - C).

Question: What if I default in payment?

Answer: We frown at defaults. A purchaser will be automatically moved to the next payment structure

when he/she defaults in payment. However, you have a maximum of twelve (12) months to complete payment for the land. If payment is not completed within twelve (12) months, a

surcharge of 30% will be deducted from your deposits.

Question: Would there be any development levy?

Answer: Yes. but yet to be determined. (subject to review).

Question: What is a development levy?

Answer: It is the cost paid for the placement of infrastructure within the estate.

Question: Would there be a survey fee?

Answer: Yes. #500,000 per plot for a registered survey (special consideration when buying two or more

plots).

Question: Would there be an agreement fee?

Answer: Yes. ₩200,000 per plot.

Question: Would there be an allocation fee?

Answer: Yes. \\$100,000 per plot.

Question: Will there be extra charges for commercial and corner piece plots?

Answer: Yes, commercial plots attract a 20% surcharge, while corner plots attract an additional 20%

charge.

Question: When will my plot(s) be allocated to me?

Answer: Physical allocation is done instantly. For subscribers to be eligible for physical allocation, they

must have completed payment for the plot and statutory fees.

Question: What do I get after completion of payment for the land?

Answer: Purchase Receipt, Acknowledgment Letter, and Contract of Sales Agreement. Please note that

complete payments for statutory fees must be made no later than 3 months after complete

payment for the land.

Question: When do I get my Deed of Assignment and Survey?

Answer: The Deed of Assignment and Registered Survey will be given to each subscriber who has

completed payment.

Question: Is the road to the estate motorable? **Answer:** Yes, the road to the estate is motorable.

Question: Is there any time limit to commence work on my land after allocation?

Answer: Yes, there is a 6–9 month time limit to commence work. At least a perimeter fence must be

erected on your plot. However, maintenance of undeveloped plots must be done frequently for

the safety of residents living in the estate.

Question: Can I resell my plot(s) or property?

Answer: Yes, but the company must be duly informed for documentation processes.

Question: What is the size of the plot(s)?

Answer: $50 \text{ft} \times 100 \text{ft} = 500 \text{sqm}$
